Mr. Arnold Donald

Arnold is President and Chief Executive Officer of Carnival Corporation & plc, a role he's held since July 2013. Arnold W. Donald has also been a director of Carnival Corporation since 2001 and a director of Carnival plc since 2003. From 2000 to 2005, Mr. Donald was the Chairman of the Board of Merisant Company, a manufacturer and marketer of tabletop sweetener products, including the Equal® and Canderel® brands. From 2000 to 2003, he was the Chief Executive Officer of Merisant Company. From 1998 to 2000, he was Senior Vice-President of Monsanto Company, a company which develops agricultural products and consumer goods, and President of its nutrition and consumer sector. Prior to that, he was President of Monsanto Company's agricultural sector. Arnold was President and Chief Executive Leadership Council, a professional network of African-American executives of major U.S. companies, from 2010 to June 2012. He previously served as President and Chief Executive Officer of Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation International from 2006 to 2008.

Mr. Stein Kruse

For those of you who don't know Stein, he is Chief Executive Officer of the recently formed Holland America Group, a division of Carnival Corporation & plc., which includes Princess Cruises, Holland America Line and Seabourn, as well as Holland America-Princess Alaska land operations. Stein is also chairman of the board of MANCO, a U.K.-based entity that oversees the operations of Carnival Australia, including P&O Cruises Australia. In total, Holland America Group operates 41 cruise ships, with more than 36,000 employees worldwide delivering 25 million passenger cruise days each year. Prior to joining Holland America Line in 1999, Stein served in executive leadership roles for a global Japanese shipping company "K" Line, Radisson Seven Seas Cruises, and Seven Seas Cruise Line. Stein currently serves on the boards of the U.S. Coast Guard Foundation; World Trade Center Seattle; Saltchuk Resources, Inc.; and the University of Washington Foster School of Business Dean's Advisory Board. He is a native of Oslo, Norway, he holds a Bachelor of Science degree from Purdue University and is a graduate of Harvard Business School's Advanced Management Program.

Mr. Orlando Ashford and Mrs. Samantha Ashford, Orlando Jr. and Jackson Ashford President of Holland America Line. Orlando was appointed President on December 1, 2014. He oversees sales, marketing, revenue management, deployment, itinerary planning, public relations, hotel operations and strategy. Before joining Holland America, Orlando was president of the Talent Business Segment of global consulting firm Mercer. Previously, he was senior vice president, chief human resources and communications officer of Mercer's parent, Marsh & McLennan Companies. He held executive positions at the Coca-Cola Company and Motorola Inc. He is the author of "Talentism," examining how technology and human networks can bridge skills gaps, enhance business performance and improve society. Orlando is on the board of ITT Corp., Executive Leadership Council and Streetwise Partners. He holds bachelor's and master's degrees in Organizational Leadership and Industrial Technology from Purdue University.




