Mandatory Australian Immigration Inspection

Please refer to the Australian Immigration Procedures letter delivered to your stateroom concerning the mandatory immigration inspection that will take place this morning. Guests on an organized Shore Excursion must proceed to the Queen's Lounge 30 minutes before your tour departure time. ALL guests must be seen individually regardless of whether or not you plan to go ashore. The inspection will commence after we have docked, at approximately 8:30am. Guests will be called over the public address system based on the Alphabetic letter or Number on the letter delivered to your stateroom. Do not go to the gangway until your letter or number has been called. All guests must present themselves shore-side in person in the terminal building. You are required to bring your Immigration letter, ship's Guest Identification Card, your Passport, and your completed Australian Immigration Card. Your passports will be collected back from you by ship's staff immediately following the inspection and/or prior to coming back onboard. After completing the inspection you will be free to leave the terminal; you do not have to return back on board.

Mandatory Zero Count Australian Immigration

Australian Immigration requires the ship to produce a "zero count," therefore no guests will be allowed back on board until everyone has been seen by Immigration ashore. Your full adherence and cooperation is appreciated.
