The above play on words stems from our time in Cape Town, when airfreight and container shipment complications unfortunately led to us not being able to take on optimal quantities of fresh melons and pineapple.

So, in order to make our current supplies last throughout the days at sea until our next scheduled loading in Dakar, we will do the following.
