Waterboat Point

About Naturalist Vicky Moens

González Videla Base, on the Antarctic mainland's Waterboat Point in Paradise Bay, is named after Chilean President Gabriel González Videla, who in the 1940s became the first chief of state of any nation to visit Antarctica. The station was active from 1951-1958, and was reopened briefly in the early 1980s. It is now an "inactive" base, with fuel and supplies in storage in the buildings for emergency use, or in case the base were to be reactivated in the future. Occasional summer visits are made by Chilean parties and tourists. On the north edge of the station there is a sign identifying Waterboat Point as an official historic site under the Antarctic Treaty. This was the place where the smallest ever wintering-over party (two men) spent a year and a day in 1921-1922. The two men, Thomas Bagshawe and M.C. Lester, had been part of the British Imperial Expedition, but their particular project, which involved flying a number of aircraft to the South Pole, was aborted. Nevertheless, they decided to stay over for the winter and made their shelter in an old whaling boat they found on this site. Their time was not wasted, however, because Bagshawe wrote the first scientific study of penguin breeding development. And today the gentoos, probably descendants of the ones he studied, nest in the ruins of the whaleboat shelter.

Living in Stavanger, Norway, born in Belgium, growing up in a wonderfully small village surrounded by most of her family, Vicky never really had the opportunity to step out of her comfort zone and really SEE the world. From a very young age she was always passionate about animals, spending time on her uncle's farm, and later on fostering stray dogs and working with rehabilitated horses. So when adulthood came along, she took a chance and left everything behind to follow love and take a 3 year sabbatical, travelling and working in mainland Europe. Which turned into an exciting 7 year period of moving from one country to another, finding challenging jobs that would push her comfort zone that little bit further and exploring all the more new places. Today her passion for animals is burning stronger than ever, with the privilege of being able to witness so many different species around the world. Witnessing animals in their natural habitat, wild and free, is one of the most humbling things for her. She always feel very conscious about what a wonderful privilege that is, but also sees the challenges some animals are facing today. Which is why she feels it's her duty to help preserve these beautiful creatures and their habitats to the best of her abilities. As she discovered the world, bit by bit, she found out she was at her happiest whenever she was surrounded by mountains, the ocean, snow and crispy weather. So it wasn't a total surprise that she ended up living in Norway, the land of mountains and fjords! Working as a tour and mountain guide during the season and teaching yoga throughout the year, she takes tourists from all over the world to explore the great Norwegian outdoors, particularly the Pulpit Rock and Kjerag hiking trails, where they get breathtaking views of the legendary Norwegian fjords.
