Please note that the below items are essential/useful for our expedition in Antarctica.

Essential:

Rubber boots

(All landings will be wet landings, which means you will be stepping into ankle - shin deep water before getting ashore). For those guests who have hired boots they will be delivered Sunday December 2.

Waterproof Parka (provided by Seabourn delivered on November 30) Those guests who didn't receive a parka or who wish to exchange their parka for a different size please note that we will be having a parka exchange on Saturday December 1, between 9:00a and 9:45a in the Grand

Sunscreen (available in the onboard shop)

Waterproof pants (available in the onboard shop)

Warm under layers (thermal underwear, fleeces/sweaters)

Water Resistant Gloves

Useful:

Thermal socks/Scarf/Neck gaiter/Hand-/Foot warmers Sunglasses/SPF protection/lip balm Walking sticks.

If you do not have any of the above items, we highly recommend sourcing these in one of the upcoming ports or our onboard shop.

For the comfort and convenience of all guests smoking is not permitted in all indoor public areas, including guest suites and guest verandas/balconies.

Smoking is permitted on board only as follows:

- Smoking of electronic cigarettes is permitted in guest suites, as well as other designated smoking areas.
- On the starboard half of the Sky Bar Deck 9
- Smoking of cigarettes, pipes and cigars is permitted on the open terrace aft of Seabourn Square Deck 7. This is the only area on board where pipe and cigar smoking is permitted.

 Smoking of water-pipes, glass-pipes or other smoking devices is not

permitted on board.
During bunkering operations no smoking is permitted onboard and will only be permitted ashore.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be a fine of \$250 per day added to your shipboard account for any violations in guest suites & verandas. Due to IAATO regulations, between Dec 6th - Dec 15th smoking will only be permitted on the Starboard side of Sky Bar, Deck 9.
