 - Moored 7 am to 5 Pm (Tuesday)
 - Weather – Temps in 70's
 - Modern, high end city, expensive
- Tourist Info
 - GoHawaii.com
 - No shuttle required – Walk to town
- Weather – Perfect year-round – be careful of intense sun
 - Expect very pleasant weather
- Very modern cruise terminal

Transportation

- TheBus
 - Route 20 Beach Bus – stop near Aloha Tower
 - Senior Fare
 - **One-Way Fare: \$1.00 (regular fare \$2.75)**
With valid TheBus Senior Card or **valid U.S. Medicare Card**
 - **1-Day Pass \$2.00 (regular price \$5.50)**
Unlimited rides valid from 12:00 a.m. - 2:59 a.m. the following day
Ask your bus operator for the 1-Day Pass before placing your money in the farebox
- Waikiki/Ala Moana Center – Uber/Taxi about \$17
 - Taxi \$12- \$30 (traffic depending)
- Dole Plantation: Uber \$40 - Taxi \$92
- Diamond Head Trail: Uber \$19
- Arizona Memorial: Uber \$19 - Taxi \$35
- Waikiki Trolley: Hop On Hop Off - \$25
- Hanauma Bay: Uber \$27 – Taxi \$56
- Numerous Car Rental Options – May have to take Uber/Taxi to Airport to get car – Pre COVID Hertz would operate from Aloha Tower on cruise ship days
- Charley's Taxi offers private taxi tours with mini vans etc.

 - Best LocoMoco!! And you have to get some CoCo puffs!! They serve breakfast, lunch and dinner here – diner food
- Rainbow Drive In - 3308 Kanaina Avenue
 - Very local - Good place to go to or from Diamond Head. There is no healthy food here – eat on paper plates at a picnic table or take-away
- Leonard's Bakery - 933 Kapahulu Ave
 - Known for malasadas
- Helena's Hawaiian Food - 1240 N School St
 - Very Local - Kalua Pig
