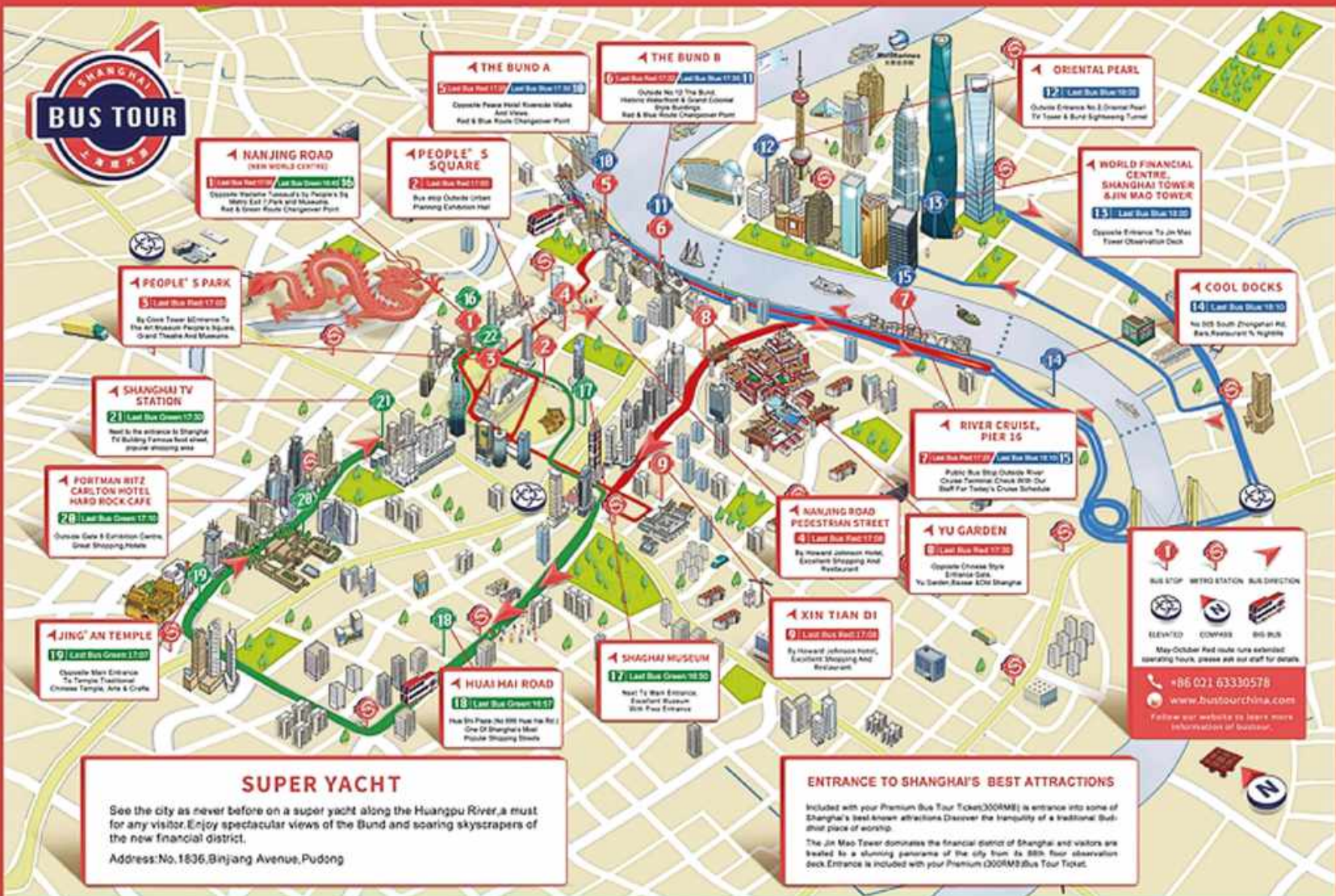

In general, restaurants don't provide napkins & washrooms don't have soap or toilet paper.

Best restaurants found in French Concession & Jing'an District



Nanjing Road  
Prices aren't fixed in the markets  
Buyers Beware: All kinds of knockoff goods...clothing to electronics



Avoid bringing only big bills  
Carry toilet paper and hand sanitizer  
Avoid eating in cheap restaurants  
Don't drink water from a tap  
Don't eat or drink in the metro  
Don't buy tickets from street vendors  
Carry a mask if sensitive to pollution

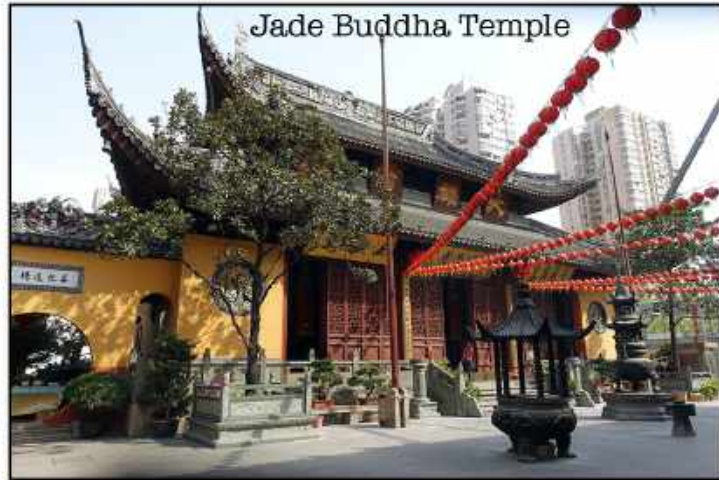

# What to do in Shanghai ?



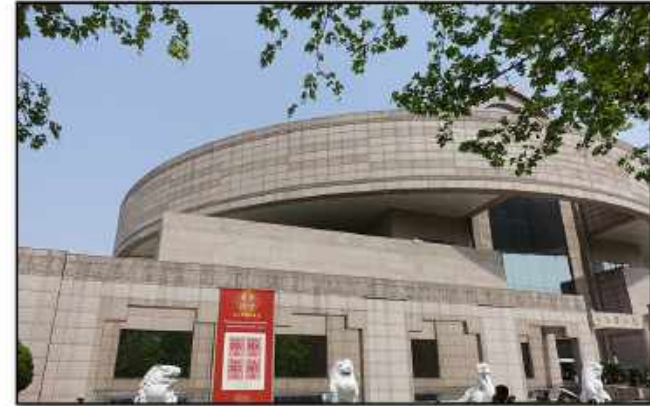
Jade Buddha Temple

- \* Also a smaller reclining jade Buddha
- \* Other Buddhas throughout
- \* CNY 20 extra 10 to see statues
