
Tauranga (Rotorua), New Zealand

- New Zealand's busiest port

Essentials

- Money US \$ usually not accepted. NZ \$ or credit card is best. \$1NZ = \$0.70US
- VISA Need NZeTA (New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority). \$9 if use app or \$12 if online. <u>https://www.immigration.govt.nz/new-zealand-visas/apply-for-a-visa/about-visa/nzeta</u>
- Safety Normal precautions.
- **Clothing** Informal/casual/comfortable. Few restaurants have dress codes.
- Internet
 - No WiFi in cruise terminal
 - WiFi available in many bars and restaurants on Mount Maunganui Road
- Cell Service 3G & 4G (no 5G)
 - 2degrees Mobile coverage along main streets only
 - Vodafone Mobile coverage along main streets only
 - Spark Mobile coverage along main streets in Maunganui and wider coverage in Tauranga
- **Tipping** Not required. 10% would be a generous restaurant tip.

Transportation

- **Taxi** Usually only a few taxis around cruise terminal.
- Bus
 - Shuttle bus To Tauranga ~\$10 round-trip. 20 min drive.
 - Little trolley train Tour around Mount Maunganui town.
 - HoHo doesn't stop at cruise terminal. Stops at the Mount Hot Salt Water Pools on Adams Ave in Mount Maunganui and Downtown Mount Maunganui.
 - Mount Maunganui public bus Salisbury Avenue bus stop is walking distance to cruise terminal. <u>https://www.baybus.co.nz/taurangawestern-bay/tauranga-and-western-bay</u>
- **Car Rental** Several near the cruise terminal. Remember to drive on the left.

Cruise Terminal

- Docked in the city's cargo port area (Mount Maunganui Port).
- Visitor information center on the dock with many representatives with lots of brochures and maps.
- No WiFi in cruise port.
- Mount Maunganui: walking distance.
- Downtown Tauranga: 20 min drive (~4 miles).

Attractions (1)

Mount Maunganui City Center

- Only a few hundred yards away from the cruise terminal. Maunganui Road is the main street. Turn right when you exit the port, follow this road for about 200 yards. Maunganui Road is at the first crossing (Burger King on corner).
- Mount Maunganui (Mauao) Extinct volcanic peak. 761' high with great views.
 - Base Track: fairly flat hike that takes about 45 minutes (3.5 km)
 - Summit Track: 2 trails go up the summit. It will take at least an hour to hike up and back. Very steep in some areas with ~500 steps.
 - No facilities at summit. Toilets at base near surf club.



Attractions (2)

- **Beaches** there are 2 within walking distance of the cruise terminal.
 - Mount Maunganui Main Beach You will find this amazing beach on the other side of peninsula at about 10 minute walk from the port. This is a great beach with lots of things to see and do like volleyball, surfing, and lots of food trucks. The waves are high here which isn't great for swimming.
 - Pilot Bay Beach The water is much calmer here which makes it better for other types of watersport like: SUP boarding, kayaking and small sail boats. There are no facilities here. As you exit the cruise terminal, you will see the beach.
