Essentials

- Money US \$ usually not accepted. AUS \$ or credit card is best. 1AUD = \$.72US
- VISA Required for US citizens. E-visa available for only \$9.95US if you use this website: https://easyeta.com/visa/
- Safety Normal precautions.
- Clothing Informal/casual/comfortable. Few restaurants have dress codes.
- Internet Many cafes and restaurants have free WiFi.
- Cell Service Along main roads: Optus and Vodafone 4G, Telstra 4G+/5G.
- **Tipping** Not required. 10% would be a generous restaurant tip.
- Taxi Taxes are metered and accept credit cards (surcharge).

Bus/Train

- Outer Harbor railway station at cruise terminal.
- No direct public bus links to cruise terminal. HAL may or may not provide bus transfer to Adelaide.
- Can buy cruise ship MetroCard for \$10 (1 day unlimited travel on any bus, train, or tram). Can purchase at Outer Harbor railway station. Bring cruise ship pass.

- Car Rental No rental cars facilities at the port. Adelaide airport is 14 miles away (~30 min).




Cruise Terminal

- We will dock at the Outer Harbor wharf.
- 2 PM Wed,15 Feb until 11 PM Thursday, 16 Feb
- There is a direct walkway from the terminal to the Outer Harbor railway station. Trains run every 30 minutes.
- Cruise terminal is 14 miles Northwest of Adelaide ~40 min train/taxi.
- Free WiFi.
- Volunteer guides at information counter inside terminal.
- Some souvenir stores in terminal.

Cruise ship terminal









Fremantle Central Area Transport "CAT" Bus Route
