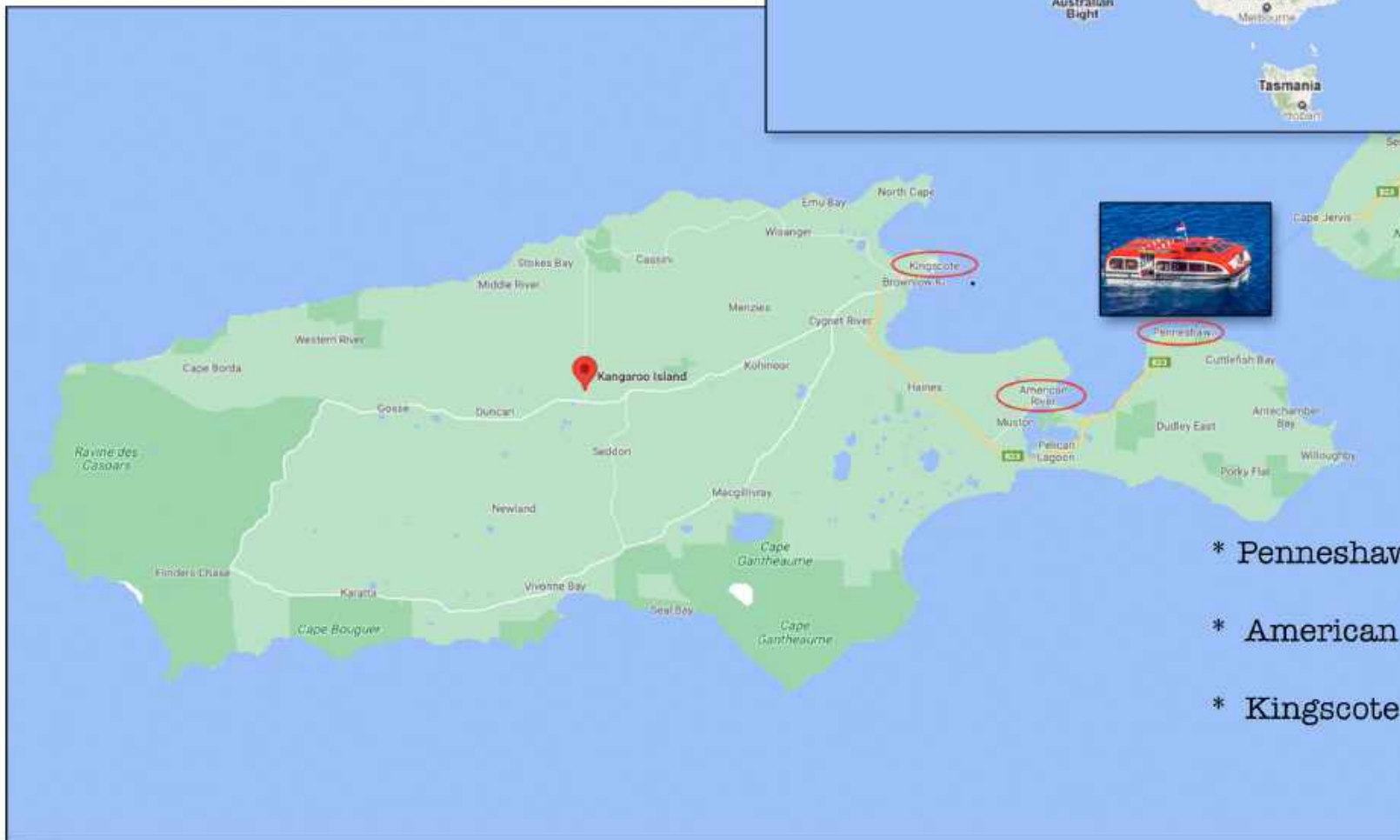


fast facts

What to do in Penneshaw?



1 Flinders Chase National Park



- * Primary Park on KI
- * Covers 17% of Island
- * Has reopened after 96% destroyed by 2019-20 bush fires
- * Short & Long walks from visitor's center
- * Limited toilets; no food or drink
- * AUD\$12 pay ahead

2 Remarkable Rocks



- * Part of National Park
- * Huge lichen covered boulders



3 Admiral's Arch

- * Natural arch-shaped rock formation with stalactites
- * An easy walk on a boardwalk around the cliff face. This leads you to a viewing platform overlooking the arch.

4 Vivonne Bay



- * Most beautiful beach
- * Small jetty
- * Near Little Sahara

5 Seal Bay Conservation Park



- * About 1.5 hours from Penneshaw
- * 500 animals
- * Beach tours AUD\$37
- * Boardwalk AUD\$16.50

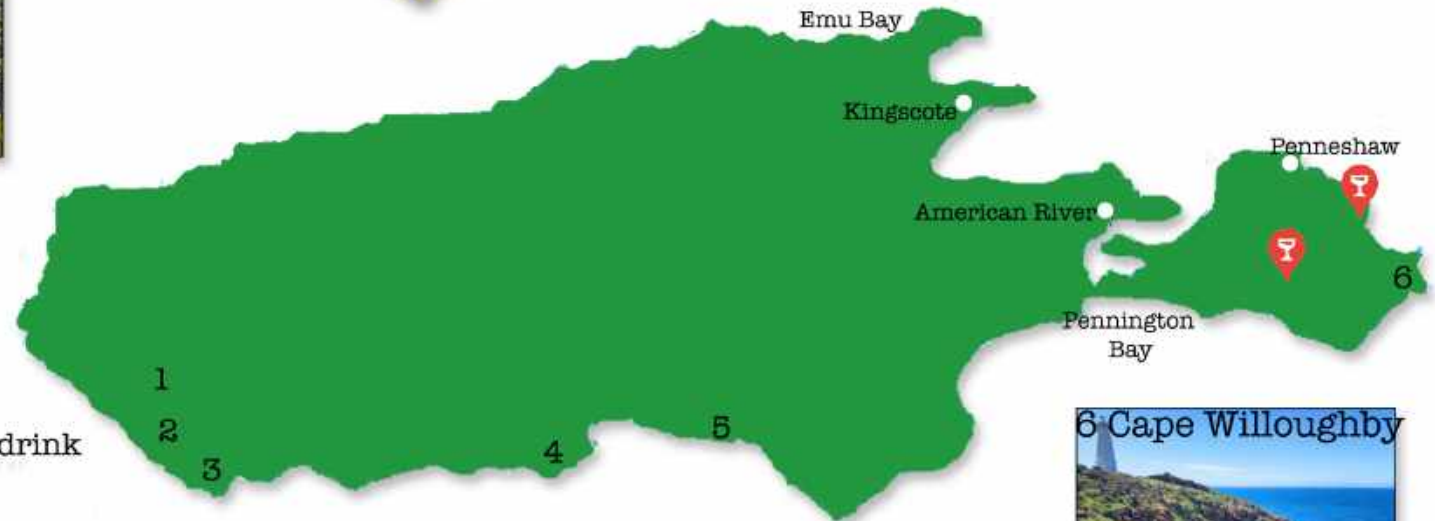
