César Manrique's Influence:

- * No building taller than palm tree
- * Electric cables underground
- * Controlled color use
- * Traditional style

1 Castillo de Punta Grande

- * Built in 1954
- * Ran aground 1981

2 Castillo de San José

- * completed 1779
- * protection from pirates
- * Museum Contemporary Art Free Entrance

3 El Charco de San Ginés

- * Lagoon of natural sea water
- * Restaurants on Northern side
- * Palm promenade

4 La Iglesia de San Ginés

- * 1665
- * In central square
- * Dedicated to patron Saint

5 El Castillo de San Gabriel

- * Originally wooden
- * Houses ethnographic museum
- * View from top €1.8

6 Gran Hotel

- * Tallest building in Arrecife
- * Restaurants, view

7 El Reducto Beach

- * Main beach
