



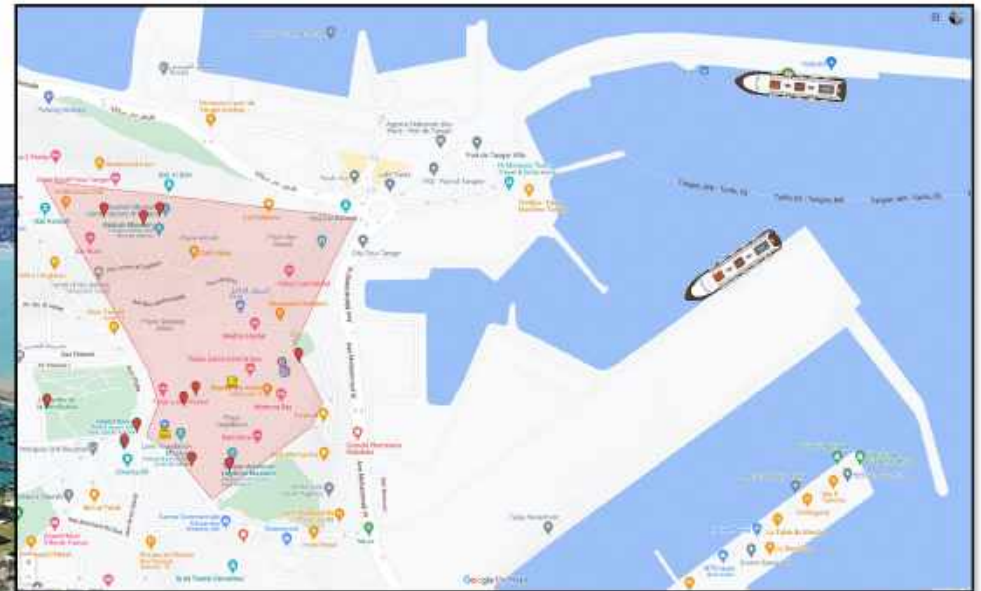

- * 1.8 million inhabitants
- * 2nd most industrial center in Morocco
- * Gateway to Africa
- * Cross cultural influence unique in Morocco:
Mix of North African, Spanish, Portuguese & French



- * Dock & passenger terminal ≈20 minute walk to city center
- * Ship shuttle, if any
- * Taxis available (about 5 euros)
- * Money changing facilities available

Not needed



Moroccan Arabic (known as Darija)
33% of people speak French as a 2nd language
English not widely spoken



Local currency is the Dirham 1 MAD \approx \$0.10
Cash based economy; Euros & US \$ widely accepted
Tipping not mandatory, but rounding up the bill is standard practice

Holds 3 passengers

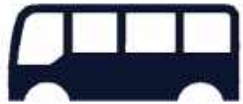
Can flag them down if empty seat

Fixed routes to specific destinations

Negotiate price before journey; credit cards not widely accepted



Limited public transport

Local Dishes:

Two of the most famous specialties are couscous and tagine

Other dishes include:

- harira (traditional tomato-based soup with legumes, spices and herbs)
- djaja mahamara (chicken stuffed with couscous, almonds and raisins)
- kalinte (chickpea pie sprinkled with paprika and cumin)
- b'ssara (fava bean soup drizzled with olive oil)
- bastilla or pastilla (filo pie with chicken, saffron, almonds, sugar and cinnamon)
- zaalouk (grilled eggplant salad with tomatoes, garlic and spices)

- * Between Medina and newer city

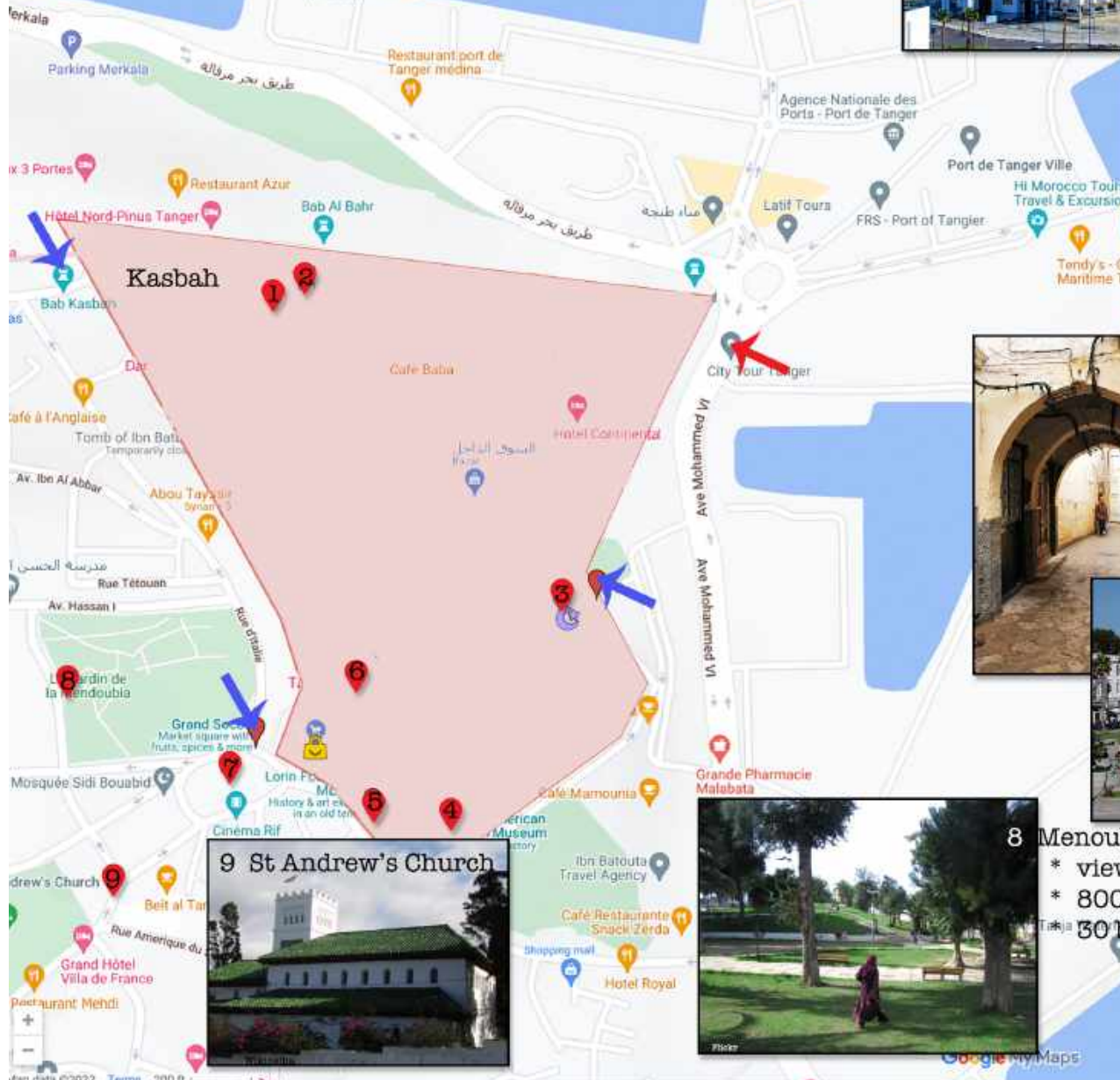


8 Menoubia Gardens
