

# **BOSTON DISEMBARKATION OPTIONS**

To organize your disembarkation in Boston, there are several options you may choose from. Please take a moment to read below and choose your preferred disembarkation plan.

## SELF ASSIST DISEMBARKATION:

Disembark at your own leisure between 7:30am and 9:30am.

Note: this option is only valid for those guests who DO NOT require any luggage or wheelchair assistance. Under this scheme, you will carry your own luggage from your stateroom to the terminal.

If you choose this option, please follow below steps:

#### **EVENING PRIOR TO DISEMBARKATION:**

- Prepare your luggage.
- Keep all your luggage inside your stateroom.
- You can refer to the reverse of this document for general disembarkation preparation and information.

# INDEPENDENT TRAVELERS:

As early as today, you may collect luggage tags corresponding to your preferred disembarkation time from the rack located by Guest Services, Main Deck 3. Please refer to the time slots allotted for the tag color and collect the luggage tag of your choice.

If you choose this option, please follow below steps:

#### **EVENING PRIOR TO DISEMBARKATION:**

- Prepare your luggage.
- Place the colored tag on your suitcase for easy identification in the terminal and retain the bottom tag stub.
- Keep travel documents (passport), medication or valuables.
- Place all tagged luggage outside your stateroom before 12:00 midnight.
- You can refer to the reverse of this document for general disembarkation preparation and information.

Club Orange, 4 and 5 Star Mariner Guests with independent plans will not need to collect luggage tags. As part of your benefits you can disembark at your leisure anytime between 8:15am and 9:30am. A disembarkation letter with corresponding luggage tags will be delivered the day prior to disembarkation

# HOLLAND AMERICA LINE AIRPORT TRANSFER OR TOUR & TRANSFER

Guests with HAL Transfers or HAL Tour & Transfers booked either pre-cruise or during the cruise will receive a disembarkation letter with corresponding luggage tags the day prior to disembarkation.

# INFORMATION FOR GUESTS WITH SELF ASSIST DISEMBARKATION AND FOR INDEPENDENT TRAVELERS



- 1. Breakfast is being served in:
  - Lido Market between 6:00am 9:00am.
  - The Dining Room 2, between 6:30am 8:30am.
  - In Room Dining not available



- 2. Onboard Account you can review your onboard statement via:
  - Stateroom Television
  - Navigator App

No final statement will be delivered to your stateroom. If you have registered a credit card, your account will automatically be settled.

With Navigator App you will have access to your on board account upon your return and from the comfort of your home.



- 3. Ensure you have the following documents to carry with you:
  - Your stateroom key card or Nav Pass for exiting the gangway
  - One luggage tag stub to show security (Independent Travelers)
  - Passport



- 4. Wait comfortably in any of the ship's public spaces or in your stateroom.
  - Proceed to the gangway only when your group or color/ number is called.
  - Congregating around the gangway or in stairwells only slows the entire process.
