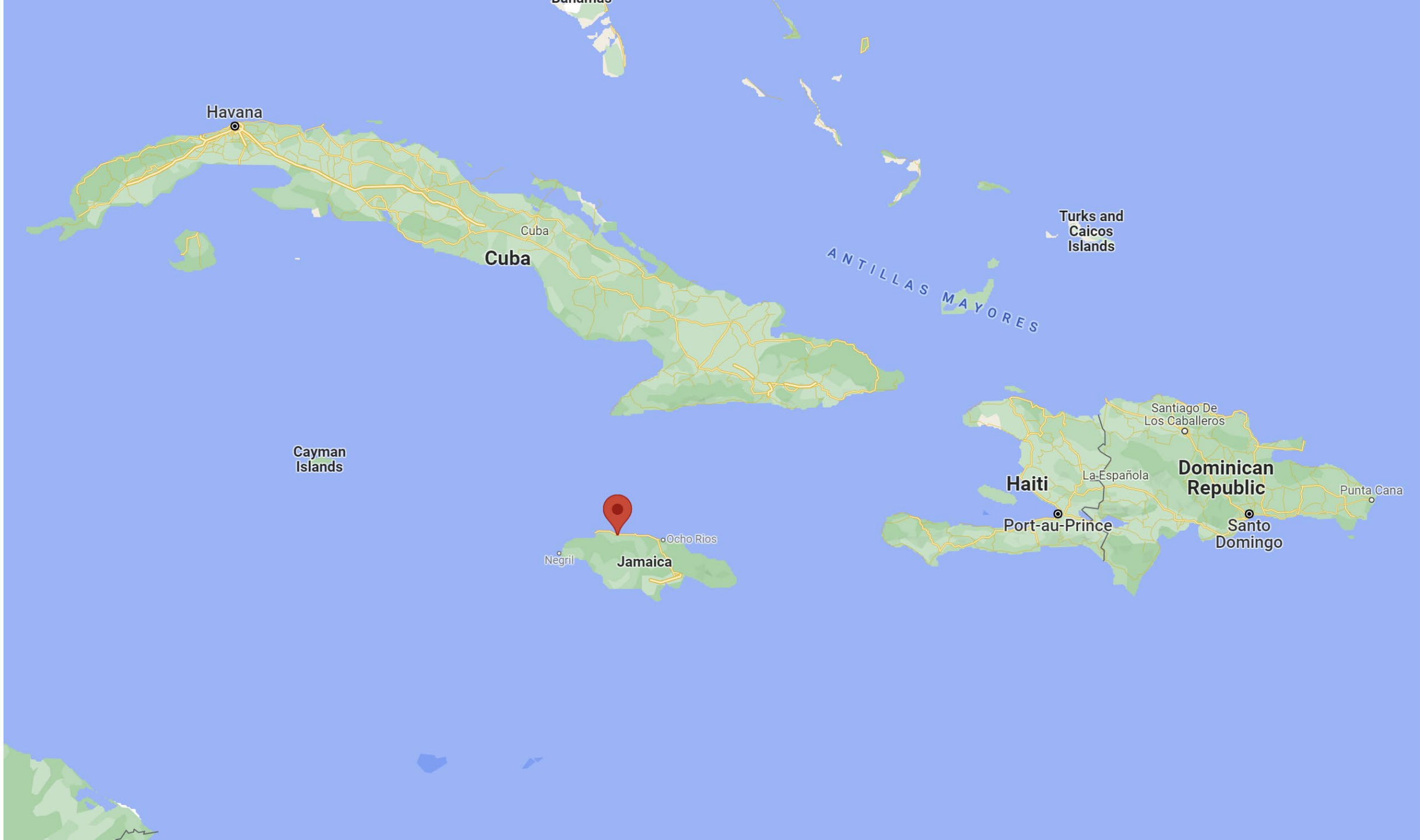

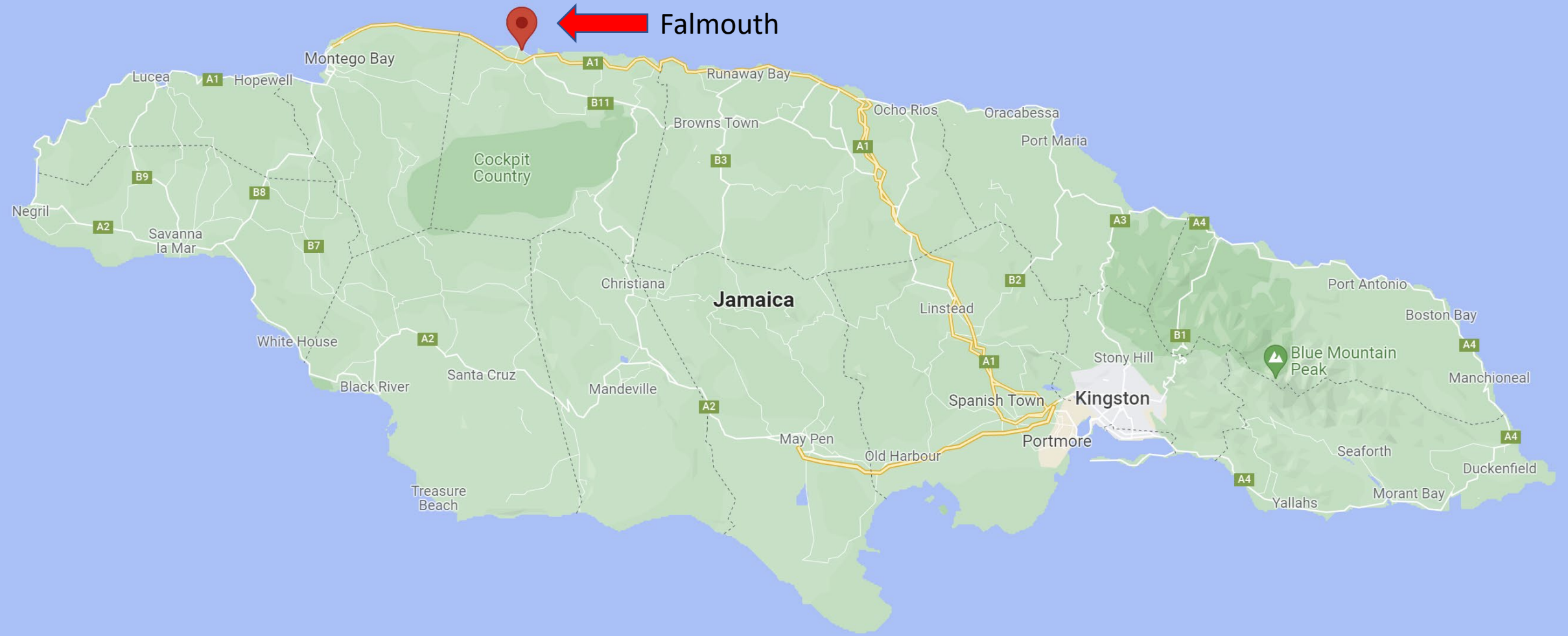

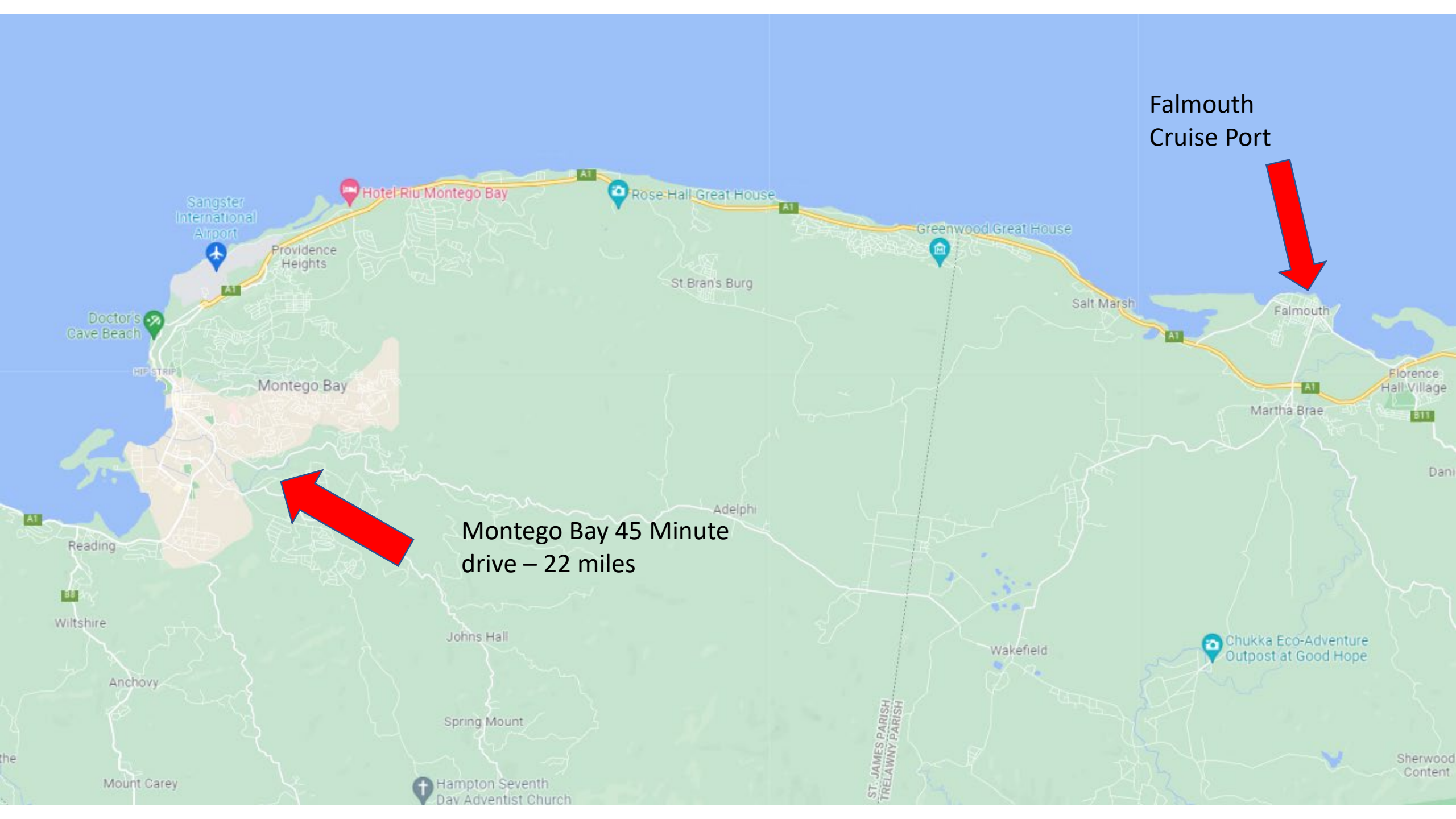

 - USD accepted everywhere
 - No need to change money
- VISA – Not required for USA Citizens
- Safety – Exercise Caution
 - Polite but firm “No Thank You” to hustlers
 - Cruise lines pulled out in 2017 – now back
- Internet – Limited
- Cell Service – All major providers
- Taxis – available inside security area – best to arrange in advance
