Which Shore Excursions Are Right for You?

Choose the tours that interest you by using the icons as a general guide to the level of activity involved, and select the tours best suited to your physical capabilities. These icons will help you to interpret this brochure.



Easy Activity: Very light activity including short distances to walk; may include some steps.



Moderate Activity: Requires intermittent effort throughout, including walking medium distances over uneven surfaces and/or steps.



Strenuous Activity: Requires active participation, walking long distances over uneven and steep terrain or on steps. In certain instances, paddling or other non-walking activity is required and guests must be able to participate without discomfort or difficulty breathing.



Panoramic Tours: Specially designed for guests who enjoy a slower pace, these tours offer sightseeing mainly from the transportation vehicle, with few or no stops, and no mandatory disembarkation from the vehicle during the tour. As vehicles outside the United States are rarely lift-equipped and ramps are seldom available, a very small amount of walking will be necessary. The pace is gentle and taking your time is encouraged.



Limited Capacity: The number of people able to participate in this tour is strictly limited. Reasons for limiting capacity may include the number of transportation seats available, or the need to maintain a safe ratio of guides for hikes, fishing and water activities. Tours require a minimum number of participants in order to operate.

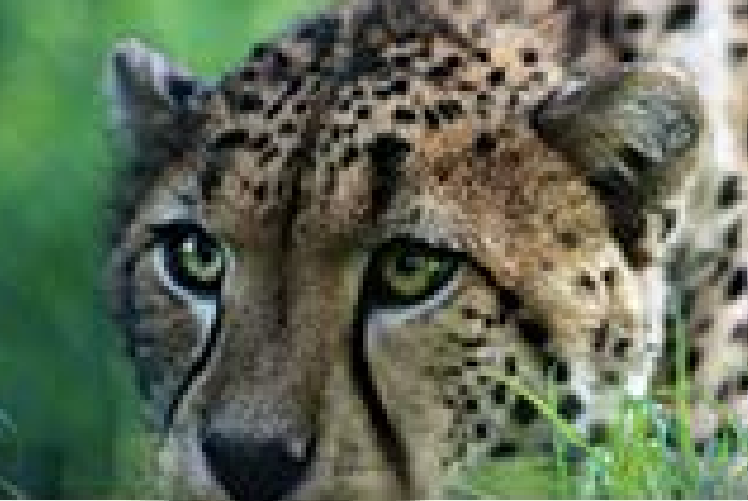


Snack: This tour includes a small snack or tasting of local specialties. The snack is not a meal.

Guests Using A Mobility Aid Device or Wheelchair

I have a disability. How do I know which tours will best suit me?

The tours are graded according to the relative level of activity they entail. The activity icons that appear at the beginning of each tour description provide a general idea of the level of activity to expect. Please see page 1 for specific information or speak to a Shore Excursions specialist (1.888.425.9376). It is important to keep in mind that tour operators are subject to the laws of their own country with respect to accommodating the needs of guests with disabilities. In most foreign countries, the laws are not as stringent as those in the United States.

Will I encounter difficulties (dis)embarking the ship when it's in port?

Please see the on-board Shore Excursions staff to help determine whether you can expect to encounter difficulties (dis)embarking the ship in a particular port of call. The decision whether or not to carry or provide other mobility assistance to a guest and their device (wheelchair, walker, etc.) up or down a ship's gangway, or on or off a tender boat, is at the sole discretion of the Captain, made based on his evaluation of guest and crew safety. We encourage you to bring a collapsible wheelchair as space limitations may restrict the ability of some tour operators to accommodate motorized mobility aid devices.

Frequently Asked Questions

What should I wear?

Comfortable walking shoes are recommended for all shore excursions. When you visit places of worship, we recommend dressing conservatively (no shorts or sleeveless tops), but casual clothing is perfectly acceptable. Dress in layers and have a jacket along. Bring an umbrella or raincoat, a hat and sunscreen.

What about meals?

Most tour departures complement the ship's meal service hours. In-room dining is available on board.

How will I know what time each tour departs?

The on-board Shore Excursions Order Form in your stateroom will show departure times. This information will also be printed on your shore excursions tickets, which you will receive on board. Approximate tour departure times are posted on our website at hollandamerica.com.

I am traveling with friends. Can we be accommodated on the same motorcoach?

The departure location for each tour is printed on

your shore excursions tickets. If you wish to travel with friends, please arrive at the designated meeting place together. This will enable the staff to allocate space for you on the same vehicle.

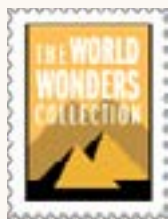

Not Included (Unless Otherwise Noted)

Guests' entrance fees for attractions are not included in the price due to the wide range of attraction possibilities, uncertain number of attractions to be visited, and varying number of guests participating. We strongly recommend that you bring some local currency to cover such costs as credit cards are not readily accepted in some ports. Lunch will not be included on any tour as many guests prefer to select their own dining venue.

Piraeus (Athens), Greece - Saturday, April 19, 2025: The port of Piraeus is your gateway to the wonders of Athens, including the Acropolis, Constitution Square, Hadrian's Arch, the Olympic Stadium and more.

Athens & the Acropolis: Airport
Pick-up & Transfer to the Ship



Departs: 12:30 PM

Only available for guests flying into Athens on embarkation day and **landing before 11:00am**

This convenient transfer/tour combination picks you up at the airport in Athens and takes you on a tour of the marvelous city of **Athens**; then, you'll transfer to the ship at Piraeus in time for embarkation.

Your visit today will begin with the most famous temple of the Ancient City -- the **Parthenon** -- dedicated to Athena, the patron goddess of Athens. Walking up a winding path towards the **Acropolis**, you will pass through the Propylaea and see the Erechtheum temple and the Porch of the Caryatids in the distance. Reinforced by the hand of man, the natural fortress of the Acropolis stands 230 feet above the city. You cannot help but be in awe of the view below.

On a **panoramic drive** through the city, some highlights include Constitution Square, the Royal Palace, where the Evzones keep watch in their traditional costumes, the Temple of Zeus and the Olympic Stadium.

Notes:

This tour requires considerable walking with

an uphill climb to the Parthenon. The marble steps are slippery, especially when it rains. Wear comfortable non-skid walking shoes. Shade is limited; please dress accordingly. Bring a hat and wear sunscreen. Expect dense crowding at the site. This tour is available only to embarking guests with flights arriving in Athens on embarkation day before 11am. You must meet the motorcoach at the airport Exit B. The tour will depart after all guests on flights landing have landed. Waiting time may be required. **Air details are required 30 days before arrival.** If you have already purchased a transfer to the ship with your cruise booking, a refund will be processed on board the ship, as this excursion automatically includes a transfer. This tour is not available to guests staying at Pre-Cruise Hotels in Athens before embarkation day.

Naples (Pompeii/Amalfi), Italy - Monday, April 21, 2025: The boisterous birthplace of marinara boasts churches, palazzi and museums galore. Nearby is Pompeii where meticulous excavation has bared the soul of a city frozen in time since AD 79.

Accessible Herculaneum Ruins & Heart of Naples



Departs: 8:30 AM

This tour is designed to be accessible for all guests, including those using a wheelchair.

Explore the fascinating ruin site of Herculaneum firsthand, including the House of Skeletons, the picturesque Old Marina, and the breathtaking Augustales Temple.

Meet your tour guide and accessible van at the cruise dock. From here, you will head out on a **scenic drive** to the ancient Roman town of **Herculaneum**. Upon arrival, you will embark on an accessible walking/rolling tour that allows you to experience the sites up close.

Your visit starts with seeing the iconic ancient town walls before making your way to the **Old Marina**, where archaeologists found more than 250 skeletons back in 1980. See the famous House of Skeletons and the Termopolium, which served as an early food bank.

You will also see the breathtaking **Augustales Temple**, thought to be the headquarters of the **Collegium Augustalium** -- a civic order of freedmen.

One of the more luxurious mansions in

Herculaneum is the **House of the Black Salon**. It presents an interesting contrast to the other highlights you have seen throughout your tour.

Enjoy a **panoramic drive** past some of the highlights of **Naples** -- Plebescito Square, the San Carlo Theatre, the Galleria Umberto covered pavilion, the Royal Palace of Naples, and Castel Nuovo -- en route back to the pier.

Notes:

This tour is designed to be accessible for all guests, including those using a wheelchair (the tour operator suggests you bring a companion to assist, as guides are not allowed to push wheelchairs). The tour route avoids stairs; however, the nature of access may differ from the standards you are familiar with at home. Accessible bathrooms with wide doors are available along the tour route. An accessible vehicle with a wheelchair lift or ramp is used for transportation. The number of accessible vehicles available is extremely limited; make your accessible shore excursion reservations as far in advance as possible. Here's your chance to discover the 2,000-year-old Roman city of Pompeii, stroll through charming Sorrento, and view the breathtaking Amalfi Coast.

Meet your tour guide and accessible van and set out on a **scenic panoramic drive** along the unparalleled **Amalfi Coast**. Take photos of the picturesque Bay of Naples and the beautiful scenic hills of Positano.

In the charming town of **Sorrento**, visit the Main Square and admire beautiful, charismatic Baroque architecture throughout the town center. Purchase lunch on your own at an Italian street café or restaurant.

This afternoon, explore the ancient **ruins of Pompeii** escorted by your knowledgeable guide. See the impressive Pompeii Necropolis and the fascinating Cast of Victims and learn about the fascinating history of this mesmerizing place frozen in time.

Ancient Herculaneum

Head out by motorcoach to the excavated city of **Herculaneum** -- known to the Italians as Ercolano. The upper-class Romans built their beautiful villas and maintained luxurious properties in Herculaneum -- most of them overlooking the sea.

Explore **on foot** with your guide, who will explain how why Herculaneum is so remarkably intact compared to Pompeii. Oddly, Herculaneum's destruction when Mount Vesuvius erupted in AD 79 preserved the city rather than wiping it out. This means that marvelous inlaid marble floors, mosaics, paintings, and carbonized wood are exposed for viewing.

Time permitting, you'll stop at a local **cameo factory** before you return to the ship.

Notes:

Use of an audio headset (included) will

enhance your tour experience. Tour requires a significant amount of walking. Wear comfortable walking shoes. Shade is limited; to avoid sunburn, wear light, long clothing suitable for use as a cover-up. Bring a hat and sunglasses; wear biodegradable/reef-safe sunscreen. Bring bottled water. Backpacks and large bags are not allowed inside the Herculaneum excavation site; lockers are not available. The coach parking is a five-minute walk from the entrance. Not advisable for guests using a wheelchair or for those with mobility limitations.

Dutch Guided: The Ruins of Pompeii

A Dutch-speaking guide leads this tour (or a guide with a Dutch interpreter). A limited number of Dutch guides and interpreters are available in this port; book early to avoid disappointment. This is not a bilingual tour; please see The Ruins of Pompeii for the same tour guided in English.

From the pier, it's a 45-minute ride by motorcoach to the ruins of **Pompeii**, perfectly preserved since the eruption of Mt Vesuvius in AD 79.

On a guided **walking tour**, you will learn about the excavation techniques that have uncovered this city remarkably intact and what the residents were doing at the time of the eruption. Gain an insight into the lives of the ancient Romans as you discover baths, theatres, temples, markets, and the huge



forum.

Time permitting, stop at a local **cameo factory** before your return to the ship and the present day.

Eating Italy: Naples Foodie Walk

Bring your appetite and your curiosity for this unforgettable **culinary tour** of one of the world's most foodie-friendly cities. Even in this dedicated, food-loving nation, no city is more famous for its cuisine than Naples. This is where pizza was invented, and coffee was perfected. Many of the other iconic Italian dishes that America loves started out right here in Naples, too. You'll discover some of the city's most distinctive eateries, learn about

the local culture, and take in some historic sites along the way on this "multi-tasking" tour that is, in fact, a multi-sensory immersion gourmet experience.

Follow your guide **on foot** between best-kept-secret gourmet hubs, handily **walking** off each tasting before succumbing to the temptation of the next one. Where you stop will depend on the day and the season.

You may visit **Scaturchio Opera Cafe**, kicking off your foodie adventure with a crash course in Italian coffee. This café claims to make Naples', and indeed perhaps Italy's, best espresso.

Exquisite, mouthwatering pastries still warm from the oven are on offer at **Sfogliatella Mary** -- some handmade love for your sweet tooth. **Pizzeria 'Ntretella** serves heaven by the slice and may be the pinnacle source of the world's favorite pie. At **Il Pizzicagnolo**, you'll experience local shop life and their **prized mozzarella**.

Not far away, a line of hungry (and choosy) locals outside tells you that you've found the legendary **Passione di Sofi**, and just when you thought you'd been there and done that, you bite into a fried pasta...

Wander back to your transportation and return to the pier in Naples.

Notes: Wear comfortable walking shoes. Tasting venues may vary; content and quality will be similar.

German Guided: The Ruins of Pompeii

Insider's Pompeii & Naples Archeological Museum in partnership with The HISTORY Channel



Departs: 8:30 AM
Approximately 7 hours

Relax and enjoy the scenery on the drive to **Pompeii** -- the world's finest example of an ancient Roman town. Set out on a **walking tour** of Pompeii, led by a professional historian guide who knows a great deal about the life and times of this city that was frozen in time by the eruption of Vesuvius in AD 79. Admire the luxurious mansions and fabulous art of wealthy patricians and visit some of the more modest homes. Explore ancient baths, temples, theaters, marketplaces, and the huge forum. Inscriptions and public notices reveal an astonishing similarity with modern times - political announcements, advertisements for wine sales, apartment vacancies and

upcoming events such as theatre performances and gladiator fights.

Take a break to enjoy a typical Italian **lunch** served at a local restaurant.

Visit the **Archaeological Museum of Naples** -- one of the most important museums in the world -- with its priceless collections of sculptures, bronzes, ceramics, paintings, mosaics, old Roman jewelry, and other works of art representing this ancient civilization. Don't miss the **'Secret Cabinet'** (opening hours permitting) -- a collection of erotic and sexually explicit finds from Pompeii, including erotic frescoes, depictions of the god Priapus, symbols, and inscriptions. Although the excavation of Pompeii was initially an Enlightenment project, once the artifacts were later classified through a new taxonomy, many were locked away in a Secret Museum, sealed in 1849. Its contents could, however, be shown for a modest fee to gentlemen but not to ladies.

Participants must be able to walk for 1.5 miles at Pompeii. Additionally, the coach parking area is a 15-minute walk (each way) to/from the entrance. Terrain includes even and uneven surfaces, cobblestones, inclines, gravel, grass, and steps. Pompeii is not wheelchair accessible. Wear comfortable walking shoes. Take to the trail immediately upon your arrival in the small village of **Oriolo Romano** and head into a whole new world. Stand in awe at the majesty and glorious colors of the stately beech trees that surround you as you begin a circular hike through this protected area.

This beech forest is part of the **Ancient & Primeval Beech Forest of the Carpathians & Other Regions of Europe**, recognized in 2017 as a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. This designation includes 94 forests across 18 countries, making it a serial site with the highest ownership globally.

Throughout your hike, learn the details of this ancient forest and its importance on a global level. **The beeches of Monte Raschio** are unusually tall. Beech trees that reach this stature are normally found at much higher elevations. Monte Raschio's fertile soils and unique microclimate, proximity to Lake Bracciano, and abundant rains make for an ideal environment. This habitat is called "depressed beech woods" -- a term that indicates the plant is growing at a lower elevation than is typical.

Minimum age is 6 years. Tour includes

Founded by King Anco Marzio around the 4th century BC, **Ostia Antica** was Rome's main commercial port and military base, with a population at its peak of nearly 100,000 inhabitants. Barbarian invasions and malaria led to the decline of the city, and eventually, all the inhabitants abandoned it. Buried for centuries by sand, the city is remarkably well preserved and, although less spectacular than Pompeii or Herculaneum, it gives a more complete picture of life in the Roman Empire.

Your visit starts with the **Via delle Tombe**, which leads to the Porta Romana -- one of the city's three gates. This is the beginning of **Decumanus Maximus** -- the main road through the town.

From the Neptune & Amphitrite Baths, **walk** to the theatre built by Agrippa and to the Forum, which formed the center of the city. Discover the main public buildings -- the Capitolium and the Temple of Rome and Augustus. There are no fewer than 18 temples dedicated to the Persian god Mithras, as well as a Jewish Synagogue dating from the 1st century BC and a Christian Basilica.

See the House of Diana and the Termopolium, an ancient Roman bar with a marble counter and a fresco representing the fruits and foodstuffs that were sold there.

You will cross the center of town en route to the **Castle of Santa Barbara**, an aging fortress built in the 16th century. Visit the best-preserved areas, such as the Main Tower (Torre del Homenaje) and the Englishmen's bastions.

From 500 feet above sea level, take in the beautiful view of the city, the bay and your ship. Inside the castle, admire some interesting Iberian archeological findings, which demonstrate that people lived there even before the arrival of the Romans.

Drive down the city's main boulevard -- the **Explanada de España**. Walk with your guide to enter the **Old Town**, which is closed to vehicles **Town Hall Square** and the Town Hall itself will surprise you with its delicate lines and Baroque style.

The Cathedral of Alicante, better known as the Church of San Nicolás de Bari, comes with an impressive façade that is one of the finest remaining examples of Spanish religious Baroque.

Step inside the **Museo de Fogueres**, which features photos and sculptures of plaster and papier mâché, depicting the different periods of the region's history.

Enjoy some **free time** to stroll in the city and perhaps try a *horchata* -- the traditional local drink made from tiger nut (earth almond) -- before you return to the ship.

All about the archaeological aspect of Alicante, this tour begins with a **panoramic drive** to the **MARQ Museum**. Here, an expert curator guide leads you through the collections. The MARQ is an archaeology museum dedicated to displaying its collection in classified and cataloged order. It is also a brilliant introduction to the various methods and techniques of preservation and restoration in the field of archaeology. These are explained in three galleries -- Field

Archaeology, Urban Archaeology and Underwater Archaeology. Dioramas, audio-visual presentations, and interactive exhibits provide visitors with a detailed insight into how archaeologists unveil the past. The information is displayed in an attractive and didactic way.

A **walking tour** through the city center brings you to the **Fogueres Museum**. This facility highlights the many celebrations and festivals held in Alicante each year, so it's all about fun and fiestas!

Return to the ship having experienced an extraordinary contrast in subject matter in each of the two museums.

Canelobre Caves & Alicante

Leaving the port area of Alicante, you will discover that, despite the small matter of the Mediterranean Sea, the city of Alicante is historically and economically more in step with North Africa than with Spain.

A **walking tour** leads you through Alicante's charming **Old Town**, located at the foot of the imposing castle.

Next, you'll drive to **Busot** to visit the **Canelobre Caves** -- a heritage site of the Valencian Autonomous Region. Within the cave is one of the highest vaulted ceilings of Spain -- about 210 feet tall -- like that of a cathedral. Admire the strange and beautiful natural works of art, including Medusa, the


candelabros (from which the name of the caves derives) and a multitude of spectacular forms.

Returning to Alicante, relax during a brief **panoramic drive** as you catch a glimpse of this bustling Mediterranean city and head back to the ship.

Enchanting Elche

The town of **Elche**, with its **palm tree forest**, boasts the highest concentration of palms in all of Europe. They number between 200,000 and 300,000, and the singular beauty of the **Palmeral of Elche** has earned the distinction of being a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Botanists believe that the Phoenicians planted this palm forest and that date palms have flourished in Elche for more than 2,000 years. The municipal park will introduce you to the world of palms and the flora of the area. Admire the abundant variety of Mediterranean species.


Visit the Baroque-style **Basilica of St Mary**, which houses the image of the city's patron saint.

The **Huerto del Cura** is an exotic garden that contains specimens of rare varieties of palm trees -- its great botanical diversity makes it

the ideal place to stroll around and admire its luxuriant plants. The fountains and the main lake, placed right at the heart of the park, are all inspired by Arabian architectural styles. This area was occupied for centuries by the Muslims.

Retail therapy alert: don't miss shopping at the **Pikolinos Store** -- the retail side of a **shoe factory** created in 1987. It sells more than 1.6 million pairs of shoes annually on five continents. This factory has gone from humble beginnings to being a leader in the shoemaking sector. Its brands are nationally and internationally famous, and recently, it was voted the best company in the Valencia Province.

Guadalest

The inland town of **Guadalest** is a fascinating example of an **Islamic fortified town**. To this day, it remains relatively unchanged from how it would have looked when the Moors occupied it hundreds of years ago.

The oldest part of the town is accessible only **on foot** through a tunnel cut into the rock.



From the main square, climb a flight of **150 steps**, which leads up to the **ruined castle**.

The village provides excellent **shopping** opportunities -- from local craft products to diverse articles from all over the world.

Medieval Alicante with A History Expert

Just 800-900 years ago, **Alicante** demarcated the frontier between the Arabs and the Christians and later between the Christian kingdoms. Its history is long and fascinating, and it's a story that deserves to be properly told, so a local history expert will guide you through the highlights today. Immerse yourself in the ancient streets, surrounded by age-old houses and medieval doors, to learn how its inhabitants lived, loved and defended themselves.

Within Alicante's **Old Town**, narrow streets and small squares contrast sharply with the castles built by feudal lords throughout southern Spain. Alicante boasts many such landmarks, including the original Castillo de Villena, Village Historica and Castillo de Biar, where history comes to life. The castles of Vinalopó are a National Monument.



Explore the **Castillo de Biar** -- this castle features an extraordinary 12th-century dome. Perched on a rocky hillside 2,460 feet above sea level, it is a Muslim-era fort that has retained its intriguing double-wall enclosure.

Return to the ship in Alicante a little more knowledgeable about this amazing region.

Drive towards **Novelda** in the province of Alicante. Novelda is located in the southern part of the wider region of Valencia and is famous for its vineyards. The city shares its borders with Elda and Petrel on the northern provincial border.

You will head to the Sanctuary of Santa Magdalena and the adjacent remains of the La Mola Castle, both located on the same hill. The sanctuary is a religious building and part of a project undertaken by Novelda-based engineer, José Sala. His design is in the Catalan Modernist style, of which he was a disciple. Take photos to fully appreciate these impressive monuments.

Next up is **Heretat de Cesilia** -- one of the region's better-known wine cellars. The origin of the winery and its products lies in the

<p>exemplary Casa Cesilia wines first produced by the Marquis de Romana in 1707. During your visit, your guide will explain the 18th-century Labor House and will introduce you to the vineyards and the modern-day winery. Here's a perfect overview of Portugal's charming capital city. Explore **Lisbon** and its amazing historical sites along the Tagus River.

Meet your guide and **accessible van** and head out on a scenic panoramic drive through the heart of Lisbon. Encounter the vibrant commercial and historic Baixa area, peppered with Portugal's neo-Classical architecture, bustling, pedestrianized streets, and trendy shops.

You will also see **Lisbon's Lower Town**, the Santa Justa Lift, and Rossio Square. Discover historical streets, traditional shops, iconic squares and ornate churches -- indicators of a prosperous past. Taste the famous *ginjinha* -- Lisbon's cherry liqueur.

In the **Belém Quarter**, pay homage to the Portuguese Discoveries period. You will see the Tagus River -- the embarkation point for Vasco de Gama's great discoveries -- and the iconic Monument to the Discoveries, the 25th April Bridge, and the Palácio de São Bento, home to the Portuguese Parliament. The

Your tour continues to the **UNESCO World Heritage Site Jerónimos Monastery**. Here, you will visit Santa Maria Church of the Jeronimos. Note the fascinating and fabulous Gothic-Manueline architecture that resulted from Portugal's immense trade wealth.

Return to the pier with a drive along the **River Tagus** and a view of the April 25 Bridge, Christ the King statue, and Praça do Comercio -- the largest square in Europe.

Notes:

This tour is designed to be accessible for all guests, including those using a wheelchair (the tour operator suggests you bring a companion to assist, as guides are not allowed to push wheelchairs). The tour route avoids stairs; however, the nature of access may differ from the standards you are familiar with at home. Accessible bathrooms with wide doors are available along the tour route. After **lunch** at a leading restaurant, continue west to **Batalha**.

Visit the magnificent 14th-century **Gothic church of Santa Maria da Victoria**. It is a great place to explore and is of historical significance because Prince Henry the Navigator's tomb is located here.

Hang Ten Lisbon: A Surf Lesson

On the **beach**, with the guidance of a skilled instructor, you'll learn the basics of **surfing**. Gear up with a wetsuit, warm up with traditional exercises and games (cardio-respiratory and physical), learn the take-off technique (standing up on the board), safety rules, how to paddle your board, catching waves, sliding-standing and, finally, a good stretch.

Head to the water and **hang ten with the locals**, putting everything you've just learned into practice. Hopefully, you'll be up on your surfboard in no time and riding the manageable waves on the beach.

Afterward, take a moment to relax on the **beach**. Then, return to Lisbon, passing the historical districts of Belem or Lisbon's city center.

The drive back to the ship will take you along the beautiful **Atlantic coastline**. At the mouth of the harbor, you will enter Lisbon via its famous **monumental district** that celebrates the glorious heyday of global exploration.

Take advantage of one last photo stop near the **spectacular memorial to Prince Henry the Navigator**. This is also the ideal place from which to see the suspension bridge across the river and the statue of Christ the King on the far bank.

Proceed to **Blue Door Cuisine**, where a chef will teach you how to prepare Moroccan mint tea. Esteemed the world over, Moroccan tea involves a rather elaborate step-by-step preparation that entices both eyes and palate.

Once you have perfected the art of tea making, roll up your sleeves and follow the chef's instructions to prepare the **perfect bread dough**. The next step is also something quintessentially Moroccan. Take your dough to the community wood-burning oven (ferran or frans), where locals mingle while they wait for their bread and pastries to bake. Frans were once found in every neighborhood, baking dozens of loaves at once. These Frans can still be found and are used by locals in the old Medinas. As so many loaves of bread were baked together, anything placed in the oven was marked with a rubber stamp.

Once your bread is done baking, sit down to enjoy a slice with locally made condiments, handmade Moroccan cookies and, of course, mint tea!

Tetouan, known as the White Dove due to the color of its buildings, was once a haven for pirates and a shelter for the Arabian refugees from Andalusia after the fall of Arabian rule in Spain. Tetouan still exhibits a profoundly Spanish influence, as it was a Territory of Spain until asserting independence in 1956. Some administrative offices' names are still in Spanish.

Begin your tour with a 35-mile drive over a gently winding road directly to the city of Tetouan, crossing the beautiful **Rif Mountains**.

However, we do our utmost to find the very best packages for your touring pleasure. Guests who leave during a tour for which transportation is included must thereafter provide for their

own transportation and services at their own expense. Transportation standards vary from country to country.

Self-Guided Touring

Guests who do not join these prearranged shore excursions must rely on whatever transportation is available in each port. If you choose to devise your own excursion, we suggest that you remind the driver or tour escort of the ship's sailing time. Of course, the ship's facilities are fully available to guests while in port.

Reservations & Online Reservations

Now you can easily choose your tour times, book your tours and receive confirmation of your shore excursions reservations 24 hours a day. Visit us online at hollandamerica.com or phone us at 1-888-425-9376. Book online now, up until 3 days before sailing. Make your payment online via our secure website, and receive confirmation as well as your tour departure times. You can also download the shore excursions, view tour prices, find answers to frequently asked questions and read general information. Remember, online and phone shore excursion reservations are processed prior to any requests made on board the ship and receive priority handling. At

the time of making your reservations online, we will advise you whether or not your reservations are confirmed or whether you have been waitlisted. Your credit card will be charged immediately for all confirmed reservations. Should space become available for a waitlisted tours request, we will e-mail or otherwise contact you at that time and either immediately charge your credit card if you have already given us your credit card information or ask you to provide us with that information for immediate charge processing. Reservations for shore excursions are subject to cancellation by us at any time prior to the credit card charge being accepted by your bank. If you or Holland America cancel a tour (except Overland Adventures and Overnights) more than 3 days prior to cruise departure, we will issue a credit on the credit card that you used to pay for the reservation. For any cancellation within 3 days of departure, a credit will not be given on your credit card. Instead, we will apply an ONBOARD CREDIT ONLY policy under which the refund (less any cancellation fee) will show up as a credit to the shipboard account of the person who was to take the tour. If the credit is not fully utilized during the cruise, the balance will be paid to that guest by the ship's Purser. Once on board, if you cancel your tour reservation after the booking deadline stated in the Shore Excursion Planning Form on board, a 100% cancellation fee will apply since transportation and services will have already been arranged. If space on the tour you have ordered is not available

you will be contacted to see if you are interested in another tour selection. You may receive confirmation of your tours via e-mail. Vouchers for each confirmed tour will be delivered to your stateroom after embarkation.

Immunizations

Immunizations may be required for some of the ports of call included in your voyage. Please contact your local physician, Health Department and/or travel medicine clinic to discuss immunization requirements for all countries on



your itinerary. You can also check the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's website at cdc.gov. Click on Travelers' Health and then Vaccinations. It is also a good idea to bring along a record of your immunizations, as requirements for immunizations may change. It is the guests' responsibility to remain apprised of changes in immunization policies, so that they have all the required inoculations and immunizations at the time of departure.

Safety

We take steps to identify and contract with reputable tour operators. Tour operators must comply with local government requirements and carry liability insurance in amounts consistent with local standards to address personal injury and property damage.

Visa Requirements

Each guest is responsible for obtaining all visas needed to join the cruise. Unless otherwise noted, it is the guest's sole responsibility to obtain any necessary visas to participate in any Overland Adventures and Overnights. Guests must keep themselves apprised of policy changes. Passports, visas (other than as specified above), tourist cards, and vaccinations, if required, are the sole responsibility of the guest. Remember, guests must have a passport that is valid for at least six months beyond the completion of their trip.

Cancellation of Signature Collection Arrangements

There is no penalty for canceling most pre-booked tours; however, if you cancel a Signature Collection private vehicle tour, a 100% cancellation fee will apply since transportation and services will have already been arranged.

Cancellation of Overland Adventures and Overnights

The cancellation policy for Overland Adventures and Overnights is (unless noted otherwise in the tour description):

- 30 - 60 days before tour date: 25%
- 14 - 29 days before tour date: 50%
- Within 14 days: Non-Refundable

Please note that the Cancellation Protection Plan covers pre-booked tours, including Overland Adventures and Overnights, if cancellation is made up to 24 hours prior to commencement of cruise. Tours cancelled within 24 hours prior to commencement of cruising or while on board are not covered by the Cancellation Protection Plan and are subject to the above penalties. In the event a complete tour is cancelled by Holland America Line or the tour operator, pre-booked refunds will be handled on board. Very shortly after each booking deadline/cancellation date, e-mails are sent from the ship to the agencies concerned, informing them of our definite requirements for meals, seats on aircraft, number of automobiles and motorcoaches, etc., and commitments are made. If notice of cancellation is received after the booking deadline/cancellation date, a refund can be assured only if the ticket is resold. Guests are encouraged to pre-purchase tours. We recommend speaking with the Shore Excursions Manager on board if you have any questions about your physical ability to take part in any tour. Should you opt not to take the tour following this discussion, full reimbursement will be made provided the cancellation is made within 24 hours of boarding the ship. For Overland Adventures and Overnights, due to the in-depth nature of the adventures, most areas are not accessible to wheelchairs and require a considerable amount of activity.
