





# ROAD TRAINS

Mighty roadtrains hauling livestock or merchandise of every description are a common sight along the outback highways of Northern Territory, Queensland, South and Western Australia. These huge giants of the road measure 50 metres in length, weigh 115 tonnes and can have up to 60 wheels. They travel at a top speed of 85 kilometres an hour, however the very latest in modern technology and high tech braking and tracking systems make them the most energy efficient and cost effective mode of road transport in Australia.

Darwin City Explorer	\$69.95	9:00 AM or 1:00 PM (3 hrs)	Explore Darwin by air-conditioned coach, passing historical landmarks tied to WWII bombings. Stop at East Point for photos and visit George Brown Darwin Botanic Gardens and the Museum & Art Gallery of the Northern Territory (MAGNT) for a brief look at tropical flora and cultural exhibits.
Darwin Heritage Walk	\$59.95	9:00 AM (2 hrs)	A 2-hour walking tour with a local guide, exploring Darwin's history, including WWII bombings and Cyclone Tracy. See reconstructed sites like the old Court House, Browns Mart, and Parliament House, plus indigenous sculptures and modern architecture. Minimum age 10.
Iconic Darwin	Adult \$109.95; Child \$89.95	9:15 AM (3.5 hrs)	Visit the Royal Flying Doctor Service Visitor Center for holographic displays on its history and WWII bombings, then explore the Darwin Aviation Museum with a rare B-52 bomber and footage of Darwin's first air raid. Includes general admission to both museums.

The Defense of Darwin	Adult \$99.95; Child \$79.95	8:45 AM (4 hrs)	Explore Darwin’s WWII history at the Darwin Military Museum, featuring the Bombing of Darwin Experience theater. Visit Charles Darwin National Park to see WWII bunkers and a scenic harbor lookout. A 500-yard walk is included.
Darwin Harbour Cruise	\$89.95	1:15 PM (2.25 hrs)	Board the Charles Darwin catamaran for a 2-hour cruise on Darwin Harbour, one of the largest natural harbors in the Southern Hemisphere. Enjoy morning or afternoon tea while learning about the area’s history and spotting wildlife like crocodiles and birds.
Darwin Pub & Craft Beer	\$99.95	1:30 PM (3 hrs)	Walk from the pier to Darwin’s CBD for a 40-minute city tour, then visit Precinct Tavern to sample four craft beers (140ml each) with a canapé. Tour the keg room and enjoy a final beer of your choice. Minimum age 18

Jumping Crocodile Cruise	Adult \$169.95; Child \$149.95	10:00 AM or 11:15 AM (5 hrs)	Cruise the Adelaide River to see jumping saltwater crocodiles in their natural habitat. Travel by coach through wetlands, then stop at Humpty Doo bush pub for a drink. A 60-minute river cruise is included.
Territory Wildlife Park	Adult \$129.95; Child \$109.95	8:45 AM (5 hrs)	Visit the Territory Wildlife Park, 988 acres of bushland with wetlands and monsoon forests. See native wildlife like raptors, nocturnal animals, and a 12-foot crocodile at the aquarium. Explore via shuttle train or trails.
Fogg Dam Conservation Reserve & Floodplains Region	\$239.95	9:00 AM (4 hrs)	Travel to Fogg Dam Conservation Reserve for a short walk through woodlands and monsoon forests to spot wildlife. Enjoy a snack at Pandanus Lookout with views of the floodplains and learn about Aboriginal and European history.





A Glimpse of the Dragon	\$109.95	7:30 AM, 8:00 AM, 8:30 AM, 9:00 AM (1.5 hrs)	Walk ~1 mile in Komodo National Park with rangers and a guide to spot Komodo dragons at Hutan Asamand. Take photos, enjoy an open bar with soft drinks at the ranger station, and see wildlife like cockatoos and pigeons. Free time for souvenirs.
Komodo Island Adventure	\$119.95	9:30 AM, 10:00 AM, 10:30 AM, 11:00 AM (2 hrs)	Trek ~1 mile to a fenced area near Banunggulung in Komodo National Park to view Komodo dragons, guided by rangers. Includes photo stops, an open bar at the ranger station, and wildlife sightings like orioles and friarbirds. Souvenir shopping at the end.
The Secret Village of Kampung Komodo	\$139.95	8:45 AM (4 hrs)	Visit Kampung Komodo village via a 30-minute wooden boat ride from Loh Lian Bay. Meet locals, visit the school, and engage with children. Then, boat to Pink Beach for swimming or snorkeling (bring own gear). No dragons on this tour; supports local community
