



- Money
 - Hong Kong Dollar– Credit cards widely accepted, but not EVERYWHERE – Bring CASH
 - Exchanged rate fixed to USD 7.8 HK\$ to \$ 1 USD
 - 100 Yen is about \$1 USD (94 cents)
- VISA – Not required for USA citizens
- Safety – Normal Precautions
- Internet – Widely available
- Cell Service – All major providers
- Taxis & Uber are widely available
- Trains/Subway
 - All major sites near a stop
 - Review YouTube to understand how the system works
- Organic Maps or Pocket Earth
- Google Translate – Download Offline files
