



## POINTS OF INTEREST

### 1. Portas da Cidade

0.8 MI / 1.5 KM

Pass through Ponta Delgada's iconic, triple-arched city gates, the historic heart of town backed by vibrant plazas and classic Azorean charm.

### 2. Igreja Matriz de Sao Sebastiao

0.8 MI / 1.5 KM

Marvel at exquisite stonework, ornate wood carvings, and centuries of devotion inside the island's most important 16th-century church.

### 3. Forte de Sao Bras

0.6 MI / 1.0 KM

Explore Ponta Delgada's 16th-century sea fort and its small naval and military museum. Enjoy the view!

### 4. Carlos Machado Museum

1.2 MI / 2.0 KM

Wander through fascinating exhibits on Azorean natural history, art, and culture in this top-rated museum in a former convent.

### 5. Jardim Botânico Antonio Borges (Botanical Gardens)

1.1 MI / 1.9 KM

Relax in a lush garden oasis filled with exotic trees, grottos, and tranquil paths.

### 6. Pineapple Plantation (Arruda)

3.9 MI / 6.2 KM

Discover the Azore's unique, greenhouse grown pineapples. Tour the farm, see the ripening fruit, and sample pineapple jams, liqueurs, and fresh slices.

### 7. Lagoa das Sete Cidades

16.0 MI / 26.0 KM

Gaze across twin volcanic lakes, one emerald, one sapphire, nestled in a collapsed caldera. A jaw-dropping natural wonder and view.

### 8. Lagoa do Fogo

18.0 MI / 29.0 KM

A "Lake of Fire" set in a volcanic crater, surrounded by untouched wilderness and hiking trails.

### 9. Furnas Hot Springs & Terra Nostra Park

27.3 MI / 44.0 KM

Relax in geothermally heated mineral pools surrounded by gardens, then savor local stew cooked underground.

### 10. Gorreana Tea Factory

20.5 MI / 33.0 KM

Europe's oldest, still family-run, tea plantation. Wander verdant fields, tour the factory, and try the tea!

## Ponta Delgada, Azores, Portugal

The Porto de Ponta Delgada Terminal, where the ship docks, is approximately 0.2 MI / 0.3 KM from downtown. The town is pedestrian-friendly. Taxis are available in port and town but rideshare is not. Public buses connect major towns, limited on Sundays. Bikes and cars are rentable.
